AN INTRODUCTION TO STRATHCONA COUNTY AND SHERWOOD PARK

There is a place that truly does have it all: a large urban centre with everything from brand name national chains to boutique shops and services; an entertainment district featuring live theatre, movies, concerts, comedy and improv; abundant nature for birdwatching, hiking, biking, cross-country skiing and kayaking; family-friendly spaces such as parks and museums; and a rich culture and history that is celebrated at every turn. That place is Strathcona County.

Strathcona County recognises that it is located within Treaty Six territory and acknowledges the contributions of Treaty Six First Nations and the Métis Nation in the Country's founding and growth.

You are warmly welcomed to the region and invited to find your adventure in Strathcona County.

The rural heartland - Strathcona County

While Sherwood Park is the seat of urban culture in the County, Strathcona is actually comprised of both urban and rural land. This makes it an ideal location for sprawling farms (which you can visit), orchards, distilleries and breweries, ranches and conversation areas. The County is famous for its **farmers' markets**, including the year-round and seasonal markets. Other ways to enjoy the County include **farm tours**, Indigenous art and culture, and exploring the outdoors in one of the many **natural/preserved areas**.

The urban escape – Sherwood Park

Sherwood Park is the urban side of the County. With a population of over 70,000, it could easily be a city. However, Sherwood Park is classified as a hamlet, (Strathcona County a specialized municipality) – and a young one at that. Established in the 1950s, Sherwood Park continues to attract a wide variety of entrepreneurs, young professionals and active families. It's easy to spend a day or even a weekend exploring Sherwood Park. The urban centre is largely walkable and **public transit** is also available.

Accommodations include the unique **Dragonfly Inn**, along with recognisable brands such as Wyndham and Best Western (see pages 7-8 for the complete list). There are several areas and plazas, including the **Sherwood Park Mall**, Millennium Ridge Retail Center, **Emerald Hills Centre** and Baseline Village Mall. Independent shops include **Revolution Boutique** and **The Statement Junkie**. When taking a break from shopping, you can enjoy a movie at Cineplex theatre or grab a bite from any number of restaurants. From **That Bar-B-Q Place** to **Bodega**, from **La Patrona** to **Suda Thai**, there is something for every taste and dining style.

You can be active in Sherwood Park and Strathcona County year round. Whether you are looking to dine, shop, hike or indulge in the area's arts and culture, you can plan it all out by downloading the **Strathcona County Adventure Guide**.

The southeastern corner of Strathcona County is defined by lakes. With no cities, towns, or villages, we are a county of hamlets! Six of our nine hamlets lay on the shores of lakes.

This area has been a gathering place for generations of Indigenous peoples, including Cree and, more recently, Métis communities.

In the early 20th century, this area was known for its popular lakeside resorts. Today, many people call this place home!

The Lake Land Loop will take you around the lakes, to the hamlets on their shores, to natural areas, and to historic sites of interest. All within the Beaver Hills Biosphere!

Round trip, this driving tour will take approximately 2-3 hours.

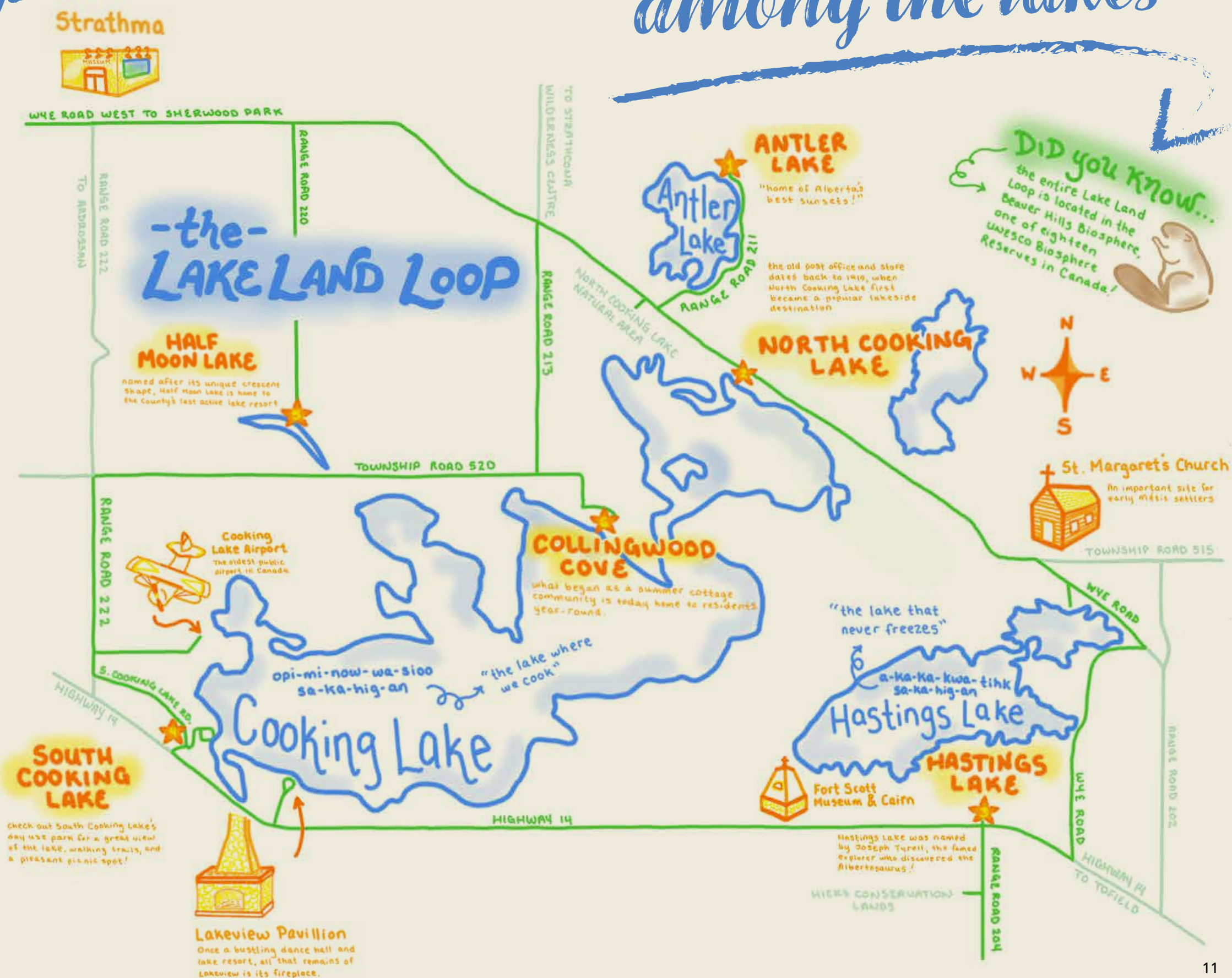

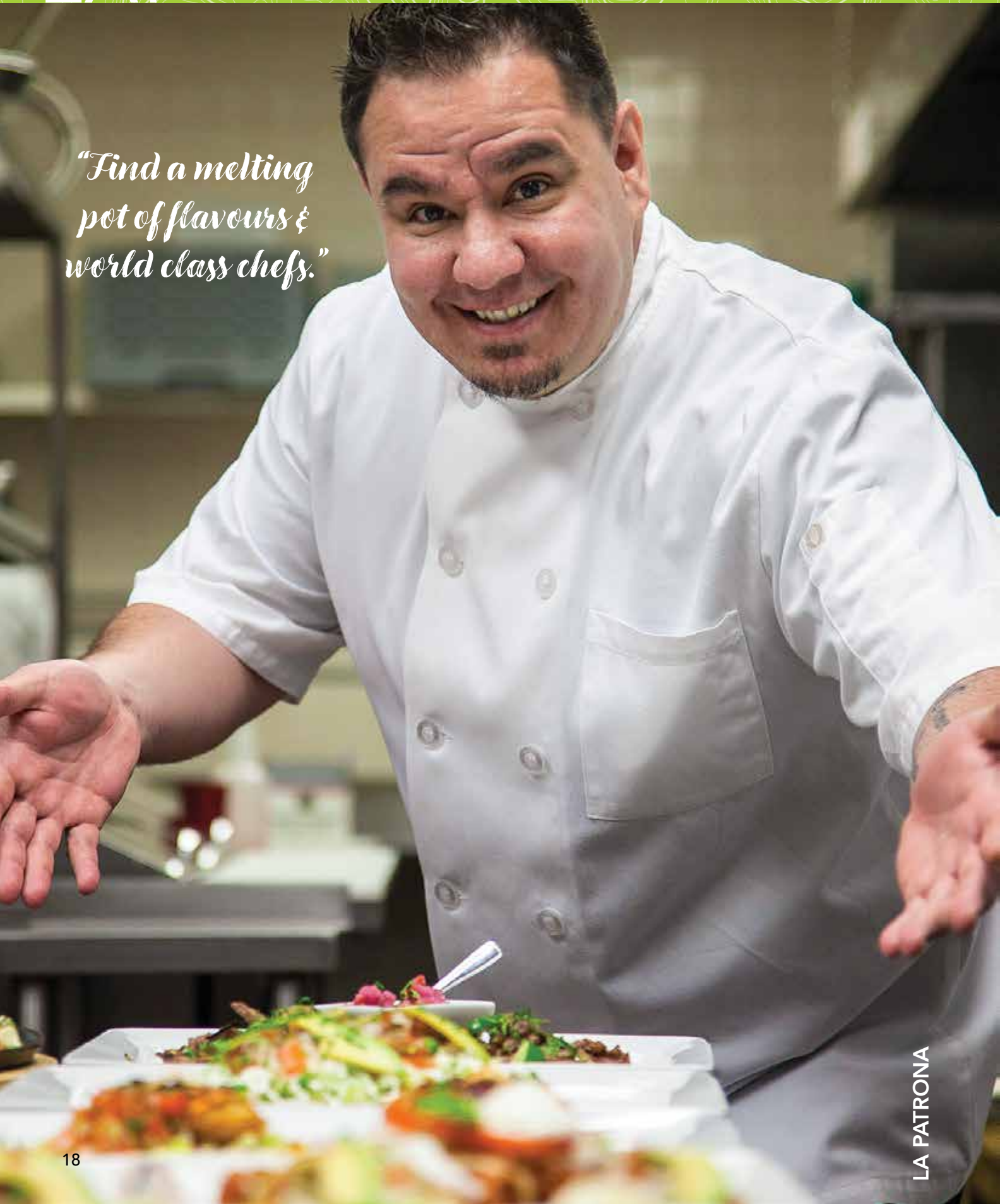

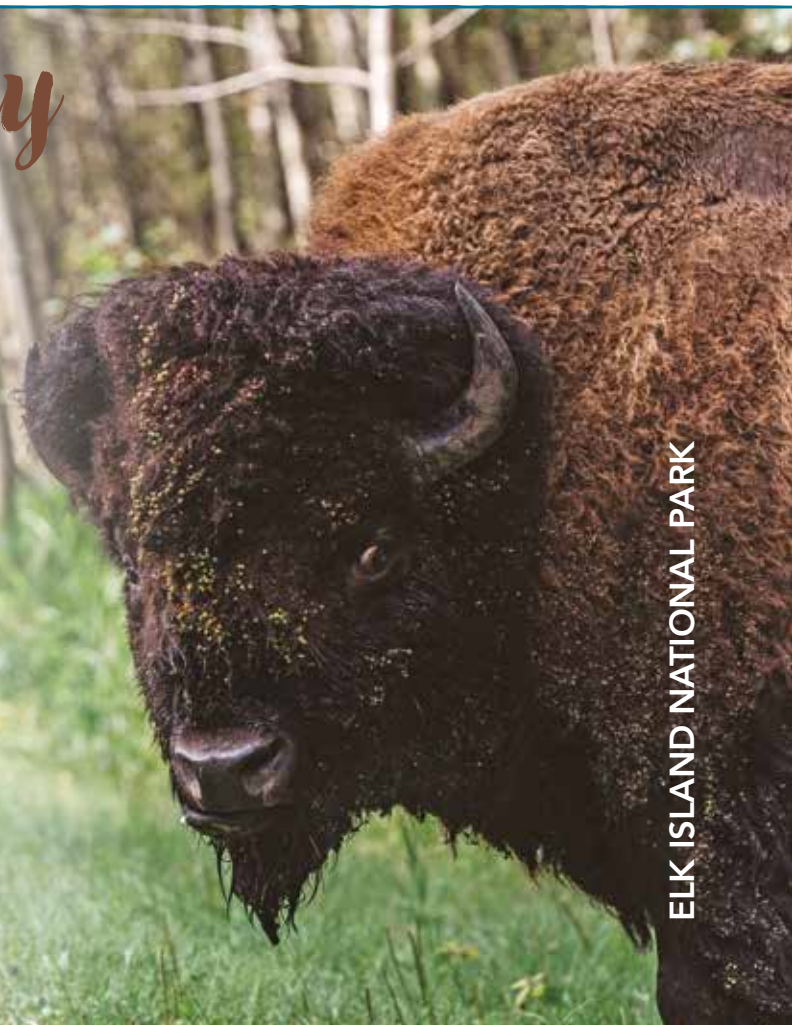
