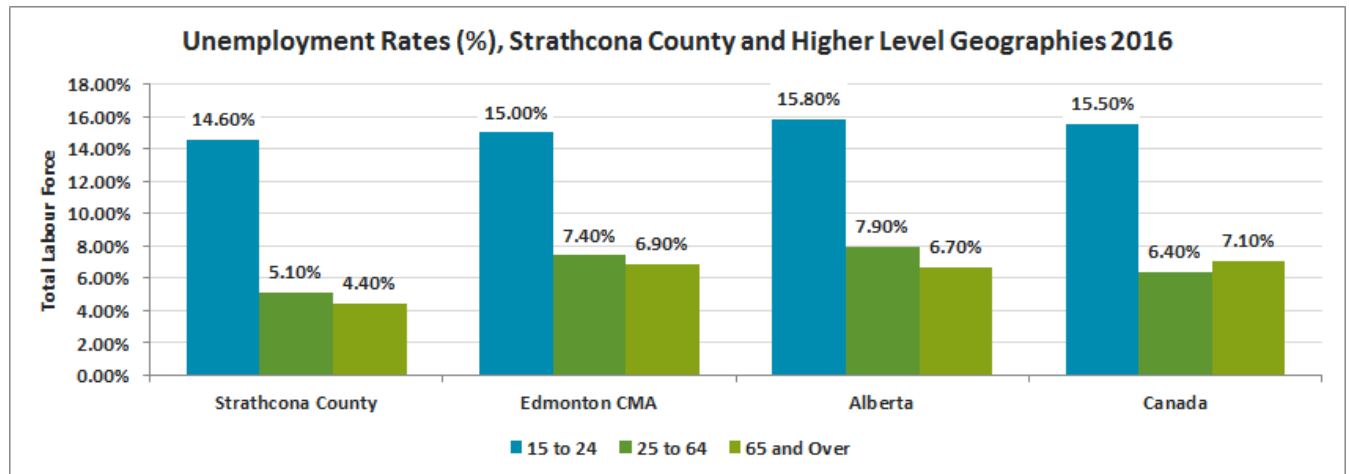
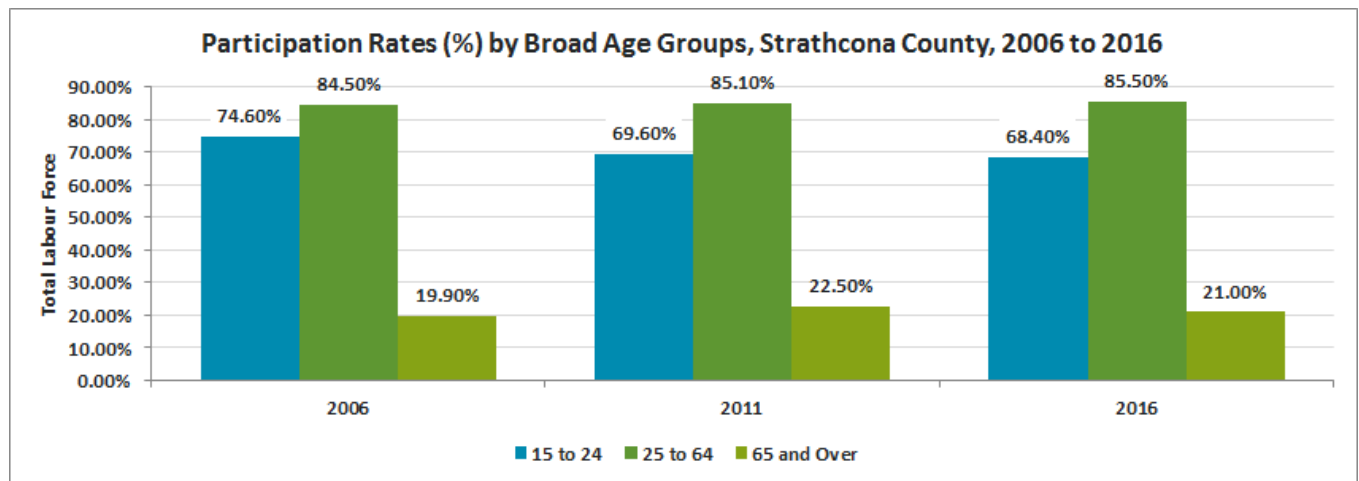
Participation and Unemployment Rates

- In 2016, unemployment rates in Strathcona County were highest in the 15 to 24 age group at 14.6%. This number has grown over the past 10 years.
- Employment rates and participation rates in Strathcona County were highest among the 25 to 64 age group from 2006 to 2016.

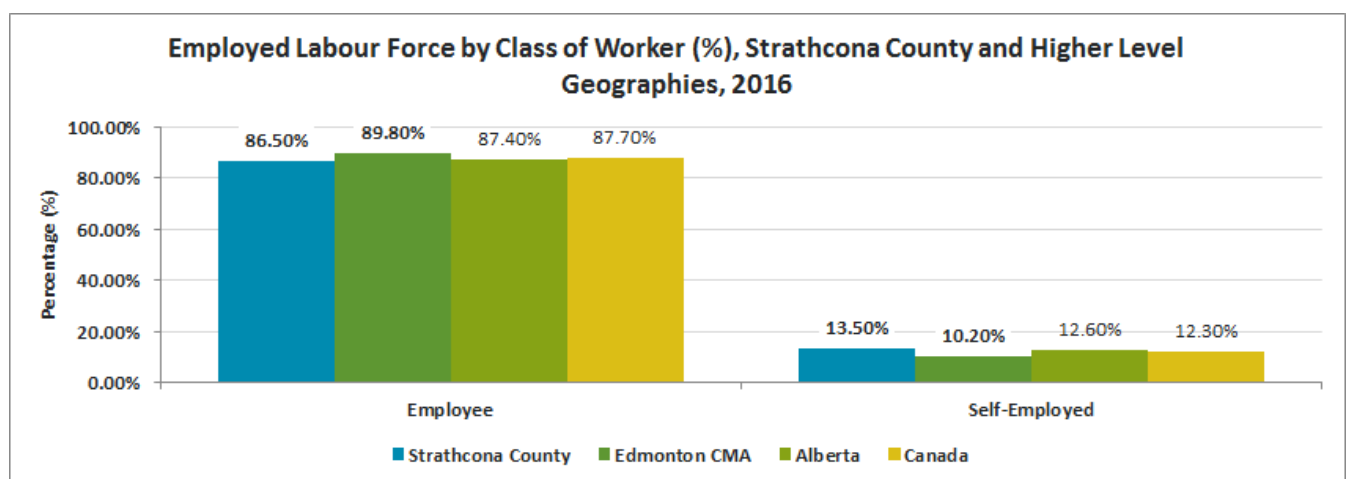
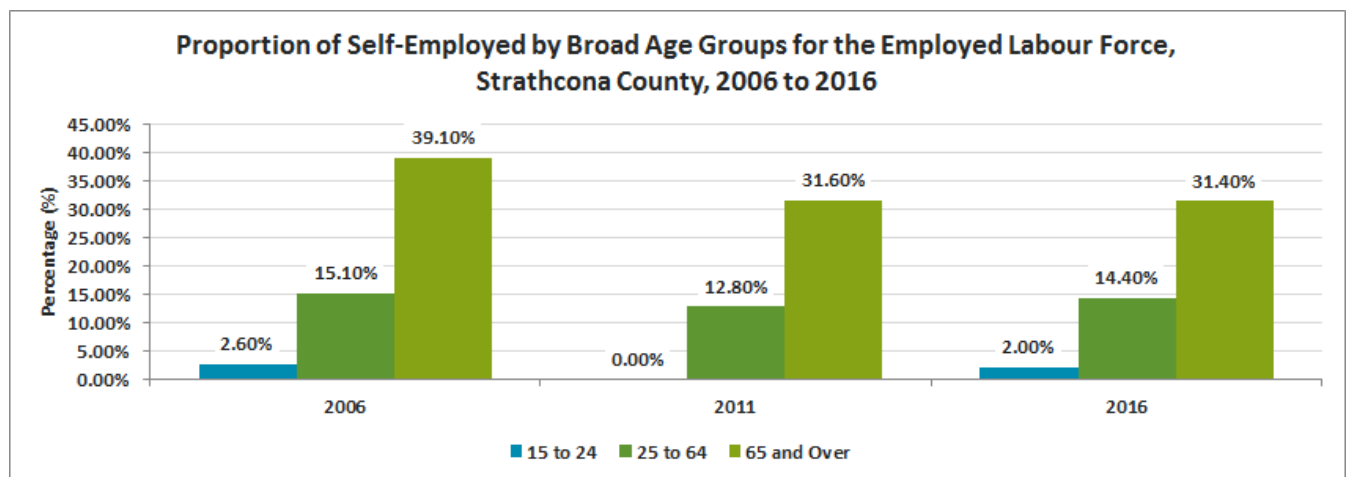

Employee vs. Self-Employed

- In 2016, 31.4% of people aged 65 and over in Strathcona County's workforce are self-employed. This age group has the highest proportion of workers that are self-employed.
- Out of Strathcona's County employed labour force in 2016, 86.5% were employees and 13.5% were self-employed. When compared to higher level geographies, Strathcona County had a higher percentage of self-employed people.

Industry Characteristics

- In 2016, the majority of Strathcona's County's employed labour force worked in construction, health care and social assistance, and retail trade.
- The industry sectors that had the greatest net growth from 2011 to 2016 in Strathcona County were healthcare and social assistance (+765 jobs) construction (+605 jobs); mining, quarrying, and oil and gas extraction (+535 jobs).
- The industry sectors that had the greatest net loss from 2011 to 2016 in Strathcona County were whole sale trade (-640 jobs) and public administration (-480 jobs).

Occupational Characteristics

- In 2016, the majority of Strathcona's County's employed labour force worked in sales and service occupations (10,135 workers) and business, finance, and administration occupations (9,805 workers).
- The occupations with the highest net growth from 2011 to 2016 for Strathcona County include sales and service occupations (+730 jobs), Trades, Transport and Equipment Operators and Related Occupations (+645 jobs), health occupations (+250 jobs) and occupations in arts, culture, recreation and sport (+215 jobs).
- The occupations with the highest net loss from 2011 to 2016 for Strathcona County include Education, Law and Social, Community and Government Services (-210 jobs) and business, finance, and administration occupations (-170 jobs).

Work Activity in the Past Year

- In 2016, 58.8% of the labour force in Strathcona County was working full time, 37.5% were working part time, and 23.9% were not working.
