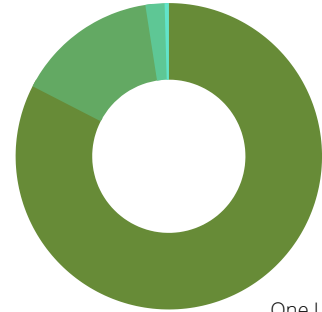

5,865 people in Strathcona County could conduct a conversation in English and French in 2021. The rate of English-French bilingualism in Strathcona County in 2021 (6.6%) is relatively stable compared with 2001 (6.9%).

In 2021, over 99% of Strathcona County's population noted that they had a working knowledge of the English language. Additionally, over 11% of Strathcona County's population had a working knowledge of a language other than English or French.

Strathcona County is home to 17,050 persons (17.4% of the total population) who know two languages or more.

Comparatively, neighbouring communities have a similar proportion of residents who know two or more languages.

The top non-official speaking languages in Strathcona County in 2021 are Tagalog, German, Punjabi (Panjabi), Ukrainian and Spanish.
