THE STATISTICS

64.8%

The working age population (15 to 64) represented 64.8% of the total population. In comparison, for Canada, the proportion of the population aged 15 to 64 was also 64.8% in 2021.

17.6%

In 2021, 17,455 children aged 0 to 14 were enumerated in Strathcona County, representing respectively 17.6% of the total population. In comparison, for Canada, the proportion of children was 16.3% in 2021.

79.6%

Single-detached houses represented 79.6% of all occupied private dwellings in Strathcona County in 2021.

The average age of the population in Strathcona County is 41.1 up from 39.2 in 2016. Strathcona County is one of the communities in the Edmonton Metropolitan Area with an average population age of over 40.

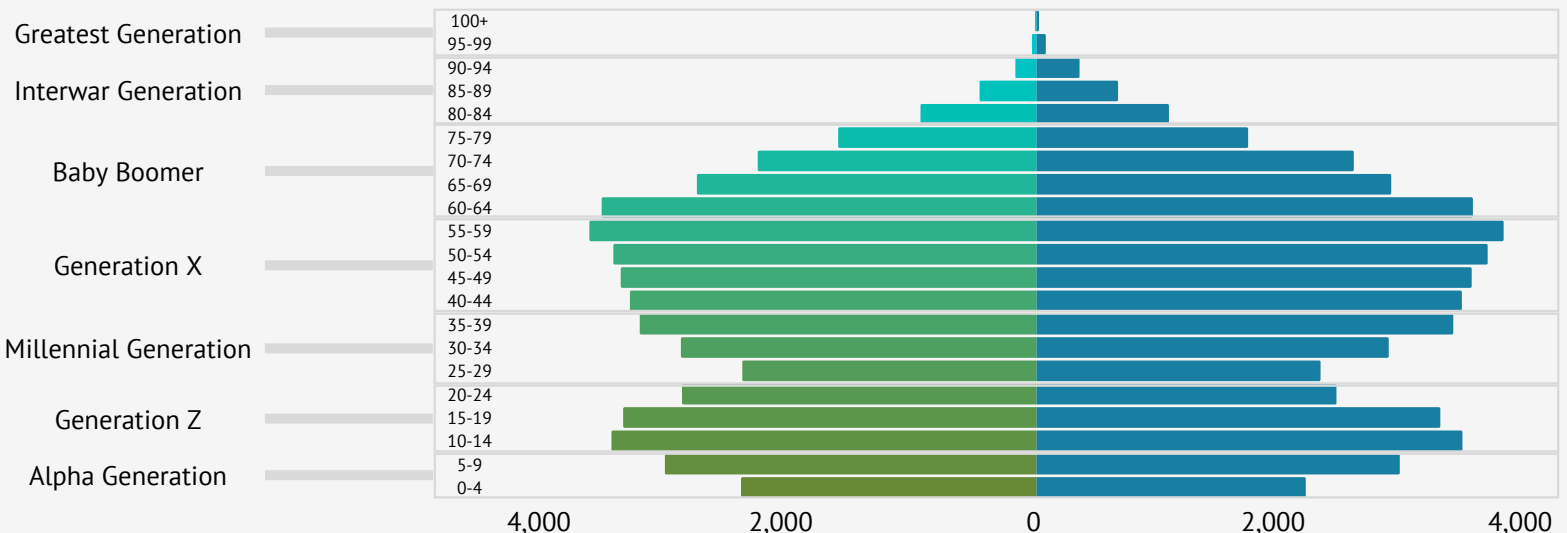


GENERATION PYRAMID
