# THE STATISTICS

**9.0%**

In 2021, 9.0% of adults aged 15 and over living in private households were living alone, compared to 7.8% in 2016.

**76.6%**

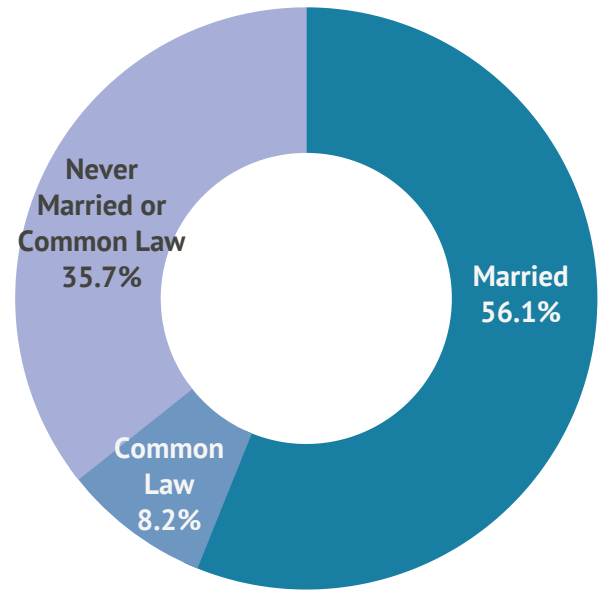
Among census families in 2021, 76.6% were married couples, 11.4% were common-law couples and 12.1% were one-parent families.

**11.4%**

In 2021, among couple families with children, 11.4% were stepfamilies.

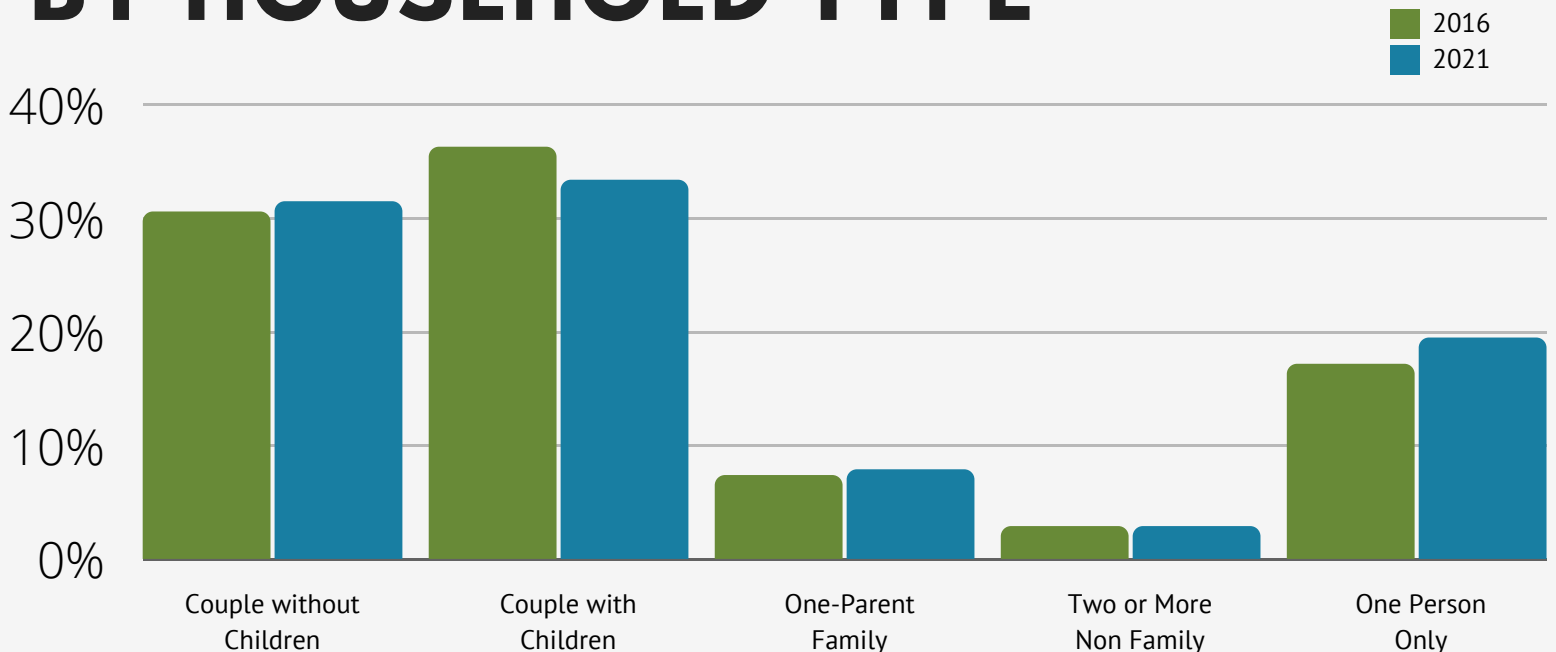
**42.4%**

In 2021, the proportion of young adults aged 20 to 34 that were living with at least one parent was 42.4%, compared to 38.5% in 2016.



In Strathcona County in 2021, 64.3% of the total population aged 15 and over were currently in a couple; either married (56.1%) or living with a common-law partner (8.2%). The remaining 35.7% were not currently in a married or common-law union.

**\$148,000**

In 2020, the average total income of households in Strathcona County was \$148,000, a change of -12.9% from \$170,067 in 2015.

**56.6%**

In 2020, the percentage of persons 15 years and older in Strathcona County with income from any COVID-19 government income support and benefits was 56.6%,Footnote2 while the percentage with income from earning replacement benefits was 26.3%.



In Strathcona County, from 2015 to 2020 the distribution of household income saw more households record an income of \$50,000-\$149,999 (1,370 more households) and less households record an income of under \$50,000 (10 less households).
