All registrants in the league are subject to the rules and regulations of the league. It is the responsibility of each registrant to obtain from the team representative(s) and read the league rules and regulations, which include a prohibition on alcohol at Strathcona County facilities unless in a licensed area or with express written permission from the County.

Registrants engage in regular season, exhibition or playoff games at their own risk and Strathcona County and the Summer Hockey League will not, in any event, be liable for damages, for injury or personal loss to any registrant, howsoever caused.

Strathcona County and the Summer Hockey League will not in any event be liable for damages for injury or personal loss to any third party, including spectators, resulting from the actions of the league players on or off the ice surface.

Registrants may also participate in events and activities related to the Summer Hockey League hosted by Strathcona County, the Summer Hockey League, or a league sponsor. Strathcona County, the Summer Hockey League and any other person or sponsor hosting such an event or activity will not in any event be liable for damages, for injury or personal loss to any registrant or participant in such events and activities.

Without limiting any of the above, the registrant is solely responsible for any and all damages suffered by the registrant or that the registrant may cause third parties as a result of alcohol consumption, including at a sponsored event or activity.

All players competing in league games or participating in league events must execute the Waiver, Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement below.

#### Waiver, Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement

I, \_\_\_\_\_ (the "Registrant") hereby acknowledge having read and understood the foregoing and agree with it in all respects. In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in the Summer Hockey League, including games and any related sponsored events, I acknowledge appreciate, and agree that:

1. The risk of injury from participation in the Summer Hockey League is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis, death or disease including but not limited to COVID-19, and while particular rules, equipment and personal discipline may reduce the risk, the risk of serious injury does exist, and
2. I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of Strathcona County, the Summer Hockey League and their respective officers, officials, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, advertisers, and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct events and activities, including sponsored activities or others ("Releasees"), and assume full responsibility for my participation, and
3. I willingly agree to comply with the league rules and regulations and customary terms and conditions for participation. If, however, I observe any unusual significant hazard during my presence or participation, I will remove myself from participation and bring such to the attention of the nearest official immediately, and
4. I, for myself, and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin hereby release and hold harmless the Releasees with respect to any and all injury, disability and death or damage to person or property whether caused by the negligence of the Releasees or otherwise and waive any and all claims of every nature and kind at law or equity or under any statute that I have or may have against the Releasees, and
5. I shall indemnify the Releasees from and against any and all claims, actions, costs, expenses, and demands brought by any person in respect of death, injury, loss, or damage, whether to person or property, resulting directly or indirectly from my participation in the Summer Hockey League and all related events and activities, including any sponsored events.

I have read this Waiver, Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement and fully understand its terms. I understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and sign it freely and voluntarily without any inducement.
