Roles and Responsibilities of Spray Deck Volunteers

- 1. Volunteers are responsible for the key they are assigned. The key must be returned to the Recreation, Parks and Culture Administration offices at the end of the volunteer assignment each year.
- 2. Sweep the deck before water is turned on in order to protect the users and prevent the drain from clogging.
- 3. Spray deck hours are from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, July and August, when the outside temperature is 20°C or greater.
- 4. If the deck is being used when you go to close it, you may wish to leave the water on for a while longer, as long as you return to shut the water off.
- 5. If the deck is clogged, please try and remove the debris. If you are unable to remove the clog and the water is not draining, please call the Recreation, Parks and Culture office during normal office hours (8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday) at 780-467-2211.
- 6. If you are unable to operate a spray deck, please contact the Programming Specialist via email at recreation@strathcona.ca.
- 7. Complete the Spray Deck Usage Tracking sheet and submit to Recreation, Parks and Culture at the completion of scheduled shifts.
- 8. Volunteers are not required or expected to supervise the children using the spray deck.
