SERVICES AT A GLANCE



BLACK CART Waste

WHAT?
Anything that cannot be composted or recycled



WHEN?
Every other week
(alternates with organics)

HOW MUCH?
All waste must fit inside the cart with the lid closed. Materials left outside the cart will not be collected. Cart and contents must weigh less than 200 lbs.

CLEAR BLUE PLASTIC BAG Recycling

WHAT?
Aluminum cans and containers; hard plastic bottles and containers (no lids or caps); newspaper; mixed paper; cardboard, flattened (max. size 2 ft x 3 ft).
Items must be clean/rinsed and dry,



WHEN?
Every week

HOW MUCH?
Unlimited quantity. Each bag or reusable container must weigh less than 50 lbs.

GREEN CART Organics

WHAT?
Kitchen scraps, food waste, pet waste, soiled papers, yard waste and loose grass clippings

NO plastic or biodegradable bags



WHEN?

Every other week
(alternates with waste)

Every week
(from early May to late September)
In Sherwood Park and the rural hamlets.

HOW MUCH?

All organics must fit inside the cart with the lid closed. Materials left outside the cart will not be collected. Cart and contents must weigh less than 200 lbs.

If your items were missed, call 780-449-5514 before 10 a.m. the next business day. Leave the items at the curbside for collection.

COLLECTION DAY CHECKLIST

- ✓ Put items for collection out **before 7:30 a.m.**
- ✓ Cart lid is completely closed
- ✓ Cart and contents weigh less than 90 kg (200 lb)
- ✓ Cart is at the edge of driveway and road (wheels in the gutter)
- ✓ Cart has one metre (three feet) of space on all sides and clear above the cart

BROADVIEW ENVIROSERVICE STATION

The Broadview Enviroservice Station, located at 101 Broadview Road in Sherwood Park is made up of two separate areas:

Broadview Recycle Station is open 7 days a week. See the Recycle Station chart below for what items are accepted.

The Enviroservice building is open Thursdays through Sundays and accepts electronics, appliances, household hazardous waste (paint, oil, propane tanks, batteries, etc.), furniture and mattresses.

§ exception around Christmas holidays

- Please leave household hazardous waste (oils, cleaners, etc.) in the original container if possible.
- Start a box for items that are not collected curbside (glass, styrofoam, etc) in your home or garage and drop them off the next time you're out.
- If your item is reusable, donate it! Consider donating your item to a local charity or non-profit. Or upcycle it on a local upcycling group.
- If you occasionally have extra waste that will not fit into your black cart, you can bring it to the Enviroservice building. A fee will apply.

COMMON ENVIROSERVICE ITEMS

- aerosol sprays
- batteries
- cleaners (bleach, acetone, household cleaners, etc)
- antifreeze
- appliances (fridge, stove, dishwasher, washer/dryer)
- propane tanks (20 lb or less)
- butane and kerosene
- cell phones
- electronics (anything with a cord)
- fire extinguishers
- fluorescent tubes and ballasts (fees / limits may apply)
- furniture / mattress (fees apply)
- insecticides and pesticides
- lawn mower (drained)
- metal
- oil (max 5 gal container)
- paint
- solvents, turpentine, varnish, lacquers, paint stipper/thinner

COMMON RECYCLING ITEMS

- aluminum containers (beverage, soup, vegetable, pie plates, take-out containers)
- beverage containers (juice boxes, milk cartons & jugs, no lids or caps)
- box board (cereal, cracker boxes, paper egg cartons)
- cardboard
- hard plastic bottles and containers (detergent, condiment, yogurt or margarine containers, clean, no lids or caps)
- magazines and catalogues
- newspaper and flyers
- paper (plain and glossy paper, envelopes, greeting cards with no decorations)
- wrapping paper (no foil)

By each of us making a small change, together we can make a big difference.
