The first draft of the Municipal Development Plan update is underway. Community feedback, along with input from County staff, existing strategies, guiding principles and other plans are being used to update existing policies and develop new policies explored through the policy options papers from Phase 3. The updated plan will also be more accessible and user-friendly, making it easier to find the information you are looking for.

To provide more time for the public, stakeholders, County staff, and external agencies to review the draft plan and provide feedback, the **project schedule has been extended from May to October 2016.**
