Consumer Fireworks Permit Conditions

1. The permit holder must ensure the following conditions are met:
 - a) Only the permit holder shall purchase, possess, handle, discharge, fire or set off fireworks.
 - b) The permit holder must follow Natural Resources Canada's recommended practice for discharging of fireworks.
 - c) Permit holder must read and follow all instructions on the fireworks. It is the responsibility of the permit holder to maintain a safe discharge radius as identified on the fireworks.
 - d) Immediately before discharge, the permit holder must call Strathcona County's burning status line at 780-464-8464 or text the word 'BURN' to 587-340-3696 to determine whether fireworks permits have been suspended.
 - e) Consumer fireworks may only be discharged from the permitted location.
 - f) Not more than 10 kg of fireworks shall be stored in a dwelling unit.
 - g) If consumer fireworks are stored in a dwelling unit, they shall be stored:
 - i. away from flammable substances and sources of ignition;
 - ii. in a manner that protects them from theft; and
 - iii. ensures that access to them is limited to the permit holder.
2. The permit holder will not discharge, fire or set off fireworks:
 - a) in a place or manner that creates a danger or constitutes a nuisance to any person or property,
 - b) on a highway, road allowance, public beach or park,
 - c) on privately owned land unless they:
 - i. first obtain the written consent of the owner of that land and the owner of neighbouring land on which debris might reasonably be expected to fall; and
 - ii. provide a copy of the consent required to the Fireworks Officer.
 - d) in a building or structure, unless:
 - i. the fireworks are specifically designed and clearly marked by the manufacturer for such use; and
 - ii. the building or structure is acceptable to the Fireworks Officer.
 - e) within 10 metres of any building, tent, trailer, canvas shelter or motor vehicle;
 - f) within 200 metres of any place where explosives or flammable liquids or combustible liquids or substances are manufactured or stored;
 - g) within 250 metres of a correctional institution as defined in the *Corrections Act*, a facility as defined in the *Mental Health Act*, a nursing home within the meaning of the *Nursing Homes Act*, a social care facility as defined in the *Social Care Facilities Licensing Act*, a hospital as defined in the *Hospitals Act*, an educational institution or a church, unless acceptable to a Fireworks Officer;
 - h) when a Fire Advisory or Fire Ban is in place or when in the opinion of a Fireworks Officer, weather conditions create an undue fire hazard; and
 - i) On or over public land as defined in the *Public Lands Act*.
3. If a projectile is discharged, it must be set up in such a manner so that when ignited, the projectile will go into the air in a vertical direction not more than 15° off the perpendicular.
4. Where ground level fireworks are discharged:
 - a) they shall be positioned out of the firing range of aerial fireworks and in a location where there is no dry grass or combustible material on the ground beneath them; and
 - b) the area shall be thoroughly wet down immediately before the fireworks are discharged.
5. The permit holder must provide a portable extinguisher having a rating of not less than 2-A or a minimum of 15L of water located not more than 45 metres from the location at which the fireworks are handled or discharged.
