

Inspection Fees

Fees must be paid at the time of the application. If applying by fax/email/mail, a service representative will be in contact with you for payment. **Do not include credit card information on this form.**

Payment information will only be used to make the authorized credit card payment for the approved one-time amount. Information provided will be processed and then immediately destroyed.

Requirements

In order to pass the inspection, the following requirements must be met, and all systems and components must be found to be in compliance with applicable codes:

1 Commercial Kitchen Exhaust System Report

An up-to-date commercial kitchen exhaust system report must be available for review at the time of inspection.

2 Commercial Kitchen Suppression System Report

An up-to-date commercial kitchen exhaust system report must be available for review at the time of inspection.

3 CO Detector

If there is a fuel-fired appliance on board, the MCO must be equipped with a current CO detector, which must be available for review at the time of inspection.

4 Propane Leak Detector

If there is a propane-operated appliance on board, the MCO must be equipped with a current propane leak detector, which must be available for review at the time of inspection.

5 Kitchen Exhaust Interlock

Fuel-fired appliances are not allowed to be operated without adequate ventilation. When a fuel-fired appliance is on board, a kitchen exhaust interlock is required and must be available for testing at the time of inspection.

Notice: Concealed Work

If any component required to be inspected is concealed prior to inspection by a Safety Codes Officer, the component may be requested to be uncovered.

Notice: Re-inspection

Any required re-inspection may be subject to a re-inspection fee, as per the current fee schedule. This fee is required to be paid before to the re-inspection takes place.

Conditions of Approval

Should an approval be issued following the inspection, the following conditions apply:

1 Deviation

No deviation from plans, specifications or information contained on the application or supporting documents shall be permitted without written authorization from the Safety Codes Officer.

2 Offence

Any person who commits a breach of any of the provisions of the Safety Codes Act or regulations made pursuant thereto is guilty of an offence under the Act.

3 Approval

The examination of plans, documents and specifications nor the issuance of an approval shall be construed to be an acceptance of any installation made or done in contravention of any provision(s) of a bylaw, an agreement or the Safety Codes Act or regulations.
