Our 30min individual skating lessons offer participants of all ages and abilities the opportunity to succeed through customized skating instruction. Individual skating lessons are offered to skaters 32M-99Y at Millennium Place (MP) or Ardrossan Recreation Complex (ARC). Parented options available (32M-5Y). Individual skating lessons are \$36 for 30min of instruction (+\$10 per additional participant of similar skating ability, 2 participant maximum). Homeschool group skating lessons are \$5.25 per participant for 45min of instruction (5 participant minimum).
