Contest Rules

Strathcona County's Agricultural Service Board Poster Contest is open to all students in Strathcona County and the City of Fort Saskatchewan who are in grades 3, 4 and 5 at the time of contest entry. This contest is awarding the following prize(s):

1. 3 - First Place Prizes (one per grade); \$100
2. 3 - Second Place Prizes (one per grade); \$75
3. 3 - Third Place Prizes (one per grade); \$50

Chances of winning are dependent on number of entries received. Contest entries will be judged by Strathcona County, Transportation and Agriculture Services Selection Committee based on creative representation of the theme "From field to fork" and visual appeal. To claim their prize, a parent or legal guardian of the winner must sign a Release, certify compliance with the Official Contest Rules, and provide the County with written consent for the County to display and reproduce the contest submission, and share the winner's image, name, and grade for promotional and exhibition purposes in physical and/or electronic format for a period of 5 years

Artwork must be the original work of the student who is submitting, with no other person owning rights to the artwork. Artwork must not contain any commercial logo unless the owner of copyright to the logo has given advance written consent for its use.

Children of Strathcona County, Transportation and Agriculture Services department employees or contractors (and those children domiciled with such persons, whether related or not) are not eligible to enter the contest.

Contest opens Monday, April 4, 2022 at 1:00 p.m. Mountain Standard Time (MT) and closes on Friday, May 6, 2022 at 4:30 p.m. MT. No purchase is necessary.
