## **BYLAW 7-2018**

## A BYLAW TO AMEND THE AGGREGATE LEVY BYLAW, 41-2009 AMENDMENT NO. 1

WHEREAS Bylaw 41-2009, the *Aggregate Levy Bylaw*, establishes a levy on sand and gravel businesses operating in Strathcona County, pursuant to Division 7.1 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000 c. M-26; and

WHEREAS updates to the *Community Aggregate Levy Regulation*, Alta Reg 263/2005 have increased the maximum amount that may be levied per tonne of sand and gravel; and

WHEREAS Strathcona County wishes to increase the amount payable per tonne of sand and gravel, in order to keep up with maintenance of the County's roads;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF STRATHCONA COUNTY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 3.5 of Bylaw 41-2009, the *Aggregate Levy Bylaw*, is amended by replacing "\$0.25" with "\$0.40";
- 2. This Bylaw comes into force on July 1, 2018.
