2022 YEAR-END SURVEY RESULTS



Strathcona County's Community Garden program helps residents and local non-profits establish community-led garden projects in County parks and green spaces. A year-end survey was available to all garden members to evaluate the 2022 growing season.

Survey Results

From October 7 to October 31, 2022 current community garden members were asked to complete a survey about the 2022 growing season. The survey was intended to help evaluate progress towards the goals of the program and to assess member satisfaction with support provided by the County. The survey link was sent to garden leaders of 20 community gardens. Note: a separate survey was sent to members of the Emerald Hills Community Garden due to the unique nature of that garden. There were 62 responses to this survey (59 complete and 3 partial).

HIGHLIGHTS

- 98% said the community garden contributes to their own sense of pride in their neighbourhood
- 85% said the community garden helps them feel more connected with other members of their garden group
- 88% said the community garden helps build trust between the people in their garden group
- 75% said the community garden helps build trust between the people in their neighbourhood
- 95% said the community garden helps them and their family eat more healthily
- 61% of respondents usually walk to get to their community garden location

SATISFACTION

- 96% were pleased with the amount of support the County provided for their community garden in 2022
- 86% were pleased with the on-site water available at their garden



What's Next?

Based on the results and comments included in the open-ended feedback, Strathcona County will look at ways to improve the Community Garden program for 2023 and future growing seasons.
