Discover patterns and textures of different trees and their bark in the school yard or forest.

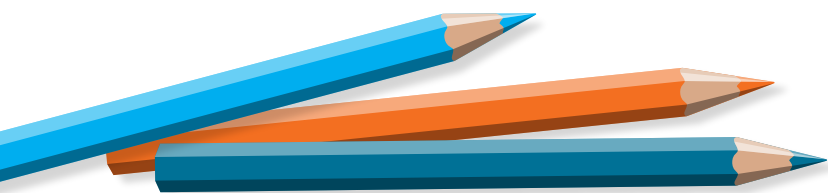
Supplies:

- White construction paper or card stock
- Crayons, pencil or charcoal
- Masking tape (optional)

Instructions:

1. Place paper on tree bark.
2. Tape or hold the paper in place.
3. Using the side of a pencil or crayon gently rub over the bark until the pattern appears.
4. Try using different colours and trees.

Try creating a large tree mural out of the classes bark and leaf rubbings.
