

## Call for Art Selection Jury Members

### Strathcona County Public Art

Strathcona County invites artists, curators and other creative professionals (such as designers and architects) to submit qualifications to join the Public Art Selection Jury Roster. This roster forms an on-hand list of interested and qualified individuals who will join other project stakeholders and assist the County in assessing artists' submissions for public art projects.

The County encourages participation from artists who are Black, Indigenous, Artists of Colour, Disabled, LGBTQQIP2SAA, and others who may face barriers to equity daily. Self-identification is optional; however, we encourage applicants to disclose details around race, gender, sexual orientation, ability, and/or membership to under-represented communities to help us improve representation, awareness, and equity.

#### The County seeks:

- Indigenous artists and arts/creative professionals in response to upcoming calls for Indigenous artist-led projects.

#### As well as:

- Individuals with training in areas relevant to public art, such as fine art, architecture, design, urban planning, art conservation, etc.
- Creative/Arts professionals with a fulsome understanding of public art in regional, national and international contexts.
- Creative/Arts professionals who possess critical understandings of race, representation, oppression, and barriers to participation in the arts.
- Applicants should reside in Strathcona County and the Greater Edmonton Region.

**Remuneration:** Strathcona County Arts and Culture follows the CARFAC-RAAV Fee Schedules for time and services jury members provide.
