

## **Notice of Construction Range Road 232 Trails**

June 30, 2021

Dear Resident,

As part of the Strathcona County Trails Strategy, trails were identified as being an essential outdoor recreational amenity. These trail linkages provide residents with opportunities to actively and safely connect to the surrounding neighbourhoods and experience a greater quality of life.

Beginning early to mid-July 2021, Strathcona County will be constructing a new asphalt trail connecting the existing trail in the Municipal Reserve (MR) adjacent to Sherwood Estates up to Range Road 232 and run along the east side of Range Road 232 to the Whitecroft Estates north access road (see enclosed map). There will also be a connection on the north side of Estate Drive east of Range Road 232. These 3m wide multi-use asphalt trails will help connect residents from the urban fringe areas to the Sherwood Park Urban Area. It will also provide a paved surface for residents to visit Salisbury Greenhouse and Farmers Market.

Construction is expected to be completed by August 2021, pending impacts from weather and unforeseen issues.

### **What to expect**

There will be minimal impacts to traffic; construction activities will take place primarily within the MR and inside the east right of way of Range Road 232. There may be a partial closer of Estate Drive and Salisbury Greenhouse access, but a portion of those accesses will remain open during construction to allow residents and customers to pass through.

To ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians, and other drivers, please respect the "Posted Speed Limit" signs and barricades, and drive through all work zones with caution.
