Survey results

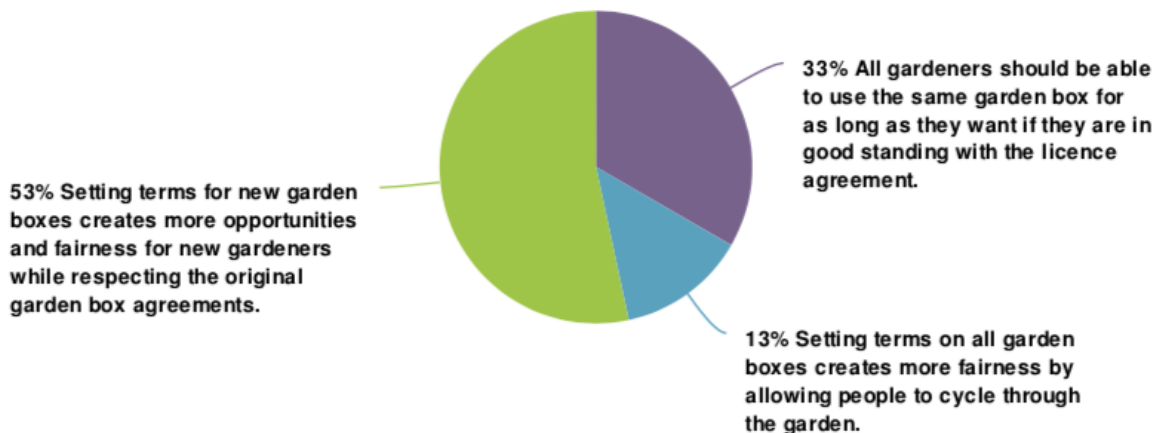
In November 2020, members of the Emerald Hills Community Garden were sent a survey to evaluate the past growing season and to gather feedback on options for plot allocation for future expansion plans. The survey link was sent to the community garden leader to share with its 20 members. There were 17 survey responses (15 complete and 2 partial).

HIGHLIGHTS

- 100% were pleased with the amount of support the County provided for their community garden in 2020
- 100% said the County communicated effectively as we dealt with the challenges around gardening during COVID-19
- 100% were pleased with the on-site water available at their community garden
- 80% said they usually walk to get to the community garden

OTHER FEEDBACK

The Emerald Hills Community Garden is popular and has a growing wait list. If the garden site expands in the future, some boxes could be designated for a limited term. This would allow more people to participate in the community garden. Respondents were asked to indicate which option they prefer:
