Range Road 210, from Township Road 550 to Highway 15, will be undergoing improvements as part of Strathcona County's Class II Road Improvements program. This program improves the quality and safety of your roadway. Construction will occur in three phases:

Phase 1) Road reconstruction from TWP 552 to Highway 15. Starts May 2022

Phase 2) Bridge replacement (830m North of TWP 550). Starts July 2022

Phase 3) Road reconstruction from TWP 550 to TWP 552. Starts Fall 2022

Our contractor, Park Paving, will be doing the construction work, so you can expect to see them working in your area. **Phase 1) Road reconstruction from TWP 552 to Highway 15 will be starting May 2022**, weather permitting. Watch for roadside message boards.

This phase of construction will include the following steps:

- 1) Road Reconstruction from TWP 552 to Highway 15 will begin on May 2, 2022 (weather permitting). Further notices will be delivered, and information signs will be displayed prior to each phase of construction.

What to expect

- During construction, access to your property will be maintained. Follow instructions from on-site flag persons and obey all construction signs. A detour map is included with this notice.
- Noise, dust and other debris can be expected in the construction zone, along with large equipment.
- Loose material and uneven surfaces may exist on the roadway. Please slow down when driving through the construction zone.

Maintain a clear right-of-way

Ditches and culverts are part of the County right-of-way that we regularly maintain to ensure proper drainage. Please do not install or add foreign objects to the ditch, such as landscaping items, decorations or signage.

Frequently asked questions

Why are you replacing the bridge on Range Road 210... It looks fine.

When we make improvements to the roadway, we review the bridge condition, width and expected lifespan. Due to the widening of the roadway and the expected lifespan of the bridge, it was determined the bridge should be replaced. By doing the bridge replacement at the same time, we extend the life of the road and minimize impacts to the residents.

Will we have access to our property?

Resident access to adjacent properties will be maintained at all times. A temporary detour around the bridge construction is required while the contractor removes and replaces the existing bridge. A map of potential detour routes is provided.

There is some debris left behind from the bridge replacement; when will this be cleaned up?

The work will be completed in three phases. During Phase 1, the contractor will complete the roadwork from TWP 554 to TWP 552. Roadway construction on Range Road 210 is scheduled to begin in May 2022 and will take two construction seasons (2022/2023) to complete. A notice will be posted before bridge construction commences. Debris from the bridge will be kept to a minimum, and the construction site will be cleaned before the contractor demobilizes.
