

Notice of Construction Range Road 210 Class 2 Road Upgrade Phase 2

To: Residents of Range Road 210 upgrade area From: Raf Tenderenda, Project Manager, Capital Projects, Strathcona County Date: June 24, 2022

Range Road 210, from Township Road 550 to Highway 15, will be undergoing improvements as part of this Strathcona County's Class II Road Improvements project. This project improves the quality and safety of your roadway. Construction will occur in three phases:

Phase 1) Road reconstruction from Twp Rd 552 to Highway 15 (Started May 2022). Paving of the first kilometre from Hwy 15 south will commence in early July 2022.
Phase 2) Bridge replacement 830m North of Twp Rd 550 (Starts July 2022)
Phase 3) Road reconstruction from Twp Rd 550 to Twp Rd 552 (Starts Spring 2023)

Our contractor, Park Paving, will be doing the construction work, so you can expect to see them working in your area. **Phase 2) Bridge replacement (830m North of Twp Rd 550) starts July 5, 2022,** weather permitting. Watch for roadside message boards.

This phase of construction will include the following steps:

 Bridge replacement. (830m North of Twp Rd 550) Vehicle access over the bridge will not be possible during bridge construction. Properties south of the bridge will have access from Twp Rd 550. Properties north of the bridge will have access from Twp Rd 552. Construction of the bridge is expected to be complete at the end of **August 2022**.

What to expect

- During construction, access to your property will be maintained. Follow instructions from on-site flag persons and obey all construction signs. A detour map is included with this notice.
- Noise, dust and other debris can be expected in the construction zone, along with large equipment.
- Loose material and uneven surfaces may exist on the roadway. Please slow down when driving through the construction zone.

Maintain a clear right-of-way

Ditches and culverts are part of the County right-of-way that we regularly maintain to ensure proper drainage. Please do not install or add foreign objects to the ditch, such as landscaping items, decorations or signage.

Frequently asked questions

Why are you replacing the bridge on Range Road 210? It looks fine.

When we make improvements to the roadway, we review the bridge condition, width and expected lifespan. Due to the widening of the roadway and the expected lifespan of the bridge, it was determined the bridge should be replaced. By doing the bridge replacement at the same time, we extend the life of the road and minimize impacts to the residents.

Will we have access to our property?

Resident access to adjacent properties will be maintained at all times. A temporary detour around the bridge construction is required while the contractor removes and replaces the existing bridge.
